

ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT 2023-2024

Our school strives to attain excellence in a happy, caring, secure and dynamic community, where we all have the opportunity to achieve our highest potential. Any prospective employee or parent of a child with individual needs should contact the school inclusion leader for more details on how the school would meet those needs.

Whiteknights Primary School is set out as a single storey building with ramped access to all parts. It has wide corridors which enable ease of movement for wheelchair users. There is a disabled parking bay in the school grounds close to Reception. Arrangements for use of this may be made by contacting the school.

We have two disabled toilets and also disabled shower facilities. Facilities have been adjusted according to need.

Pupils are taught in well-lit, enclosed teaching areas to facilitate the learning of visually and hearing impaired pupils.

Staff have undertaken a variety of training programmes; these include first aid, autism awareness, speech and language, and training to understand the SEN code of practice. We regularly liaise (as necessary) with the school nursing service, speech and language therapists, learning support service, educational psychology services, sensory consortium and other agencies such as Assist.

We work in partnership with parents to develop and implement health care plans in accordance with our medical needs policy.

We value all members of our school community and celebrate our diversity in terms of race and ethnicity and religious background, and recognise the contribution that each community makes in enriching the experiences of our pupils.
