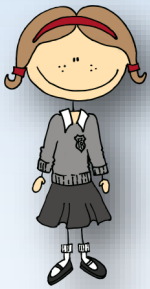

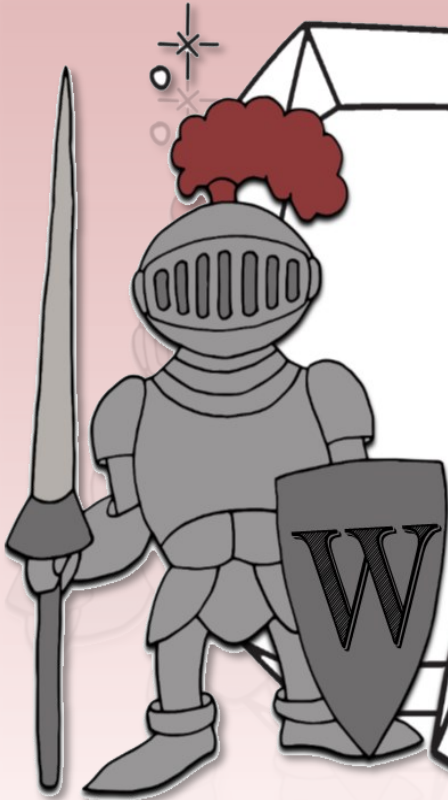


### **Good news for families and children!**

We are pleased to advise you will now be able to log in without entering your email address and password every time. You need to open up your Arbor app, enter e-mail address and password once more, tick remember password, and you will be logged in. Please then close the app down and restart the Arbor app, and it will prompt you to allow fingerprint or face ID. Alternatively, you can do this manually by going into ‘settings’ on your phone, find the Arbor App, then switch on Face ID. If this does not work you may need to update the Arbor app via the app store on your mobile phone.

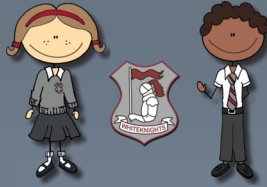

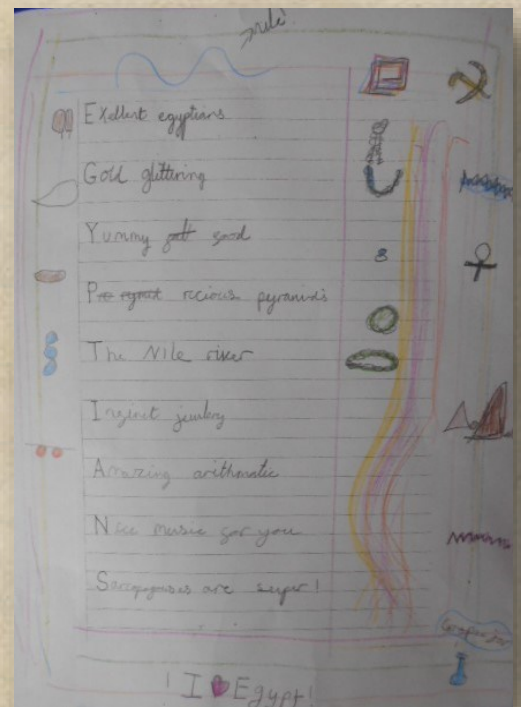

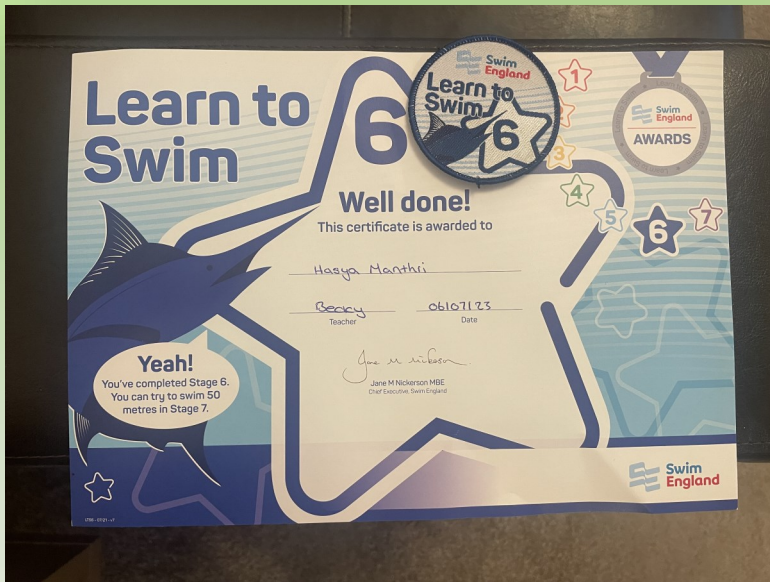


## YEAR 3 EGYPTIAN DAY

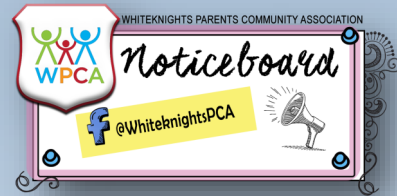
