To record an absence, click on the *Quick Actions* button (≡) at the bottom left hand corner in your app, and then click *Attendance*. From there, click the green *Log Absence* button.

Please ensure you provide a reason for the absence, including any symptoms your child is experiencing. Once the absence is logged in Arbor, school will approve or reject the absence. Approved absences will appear in the Attendance tab of your Arbor App. School will follow up all absences that are rejected.

We thank you for your patience, understanding and continued support!


### Knighthood Scheme – Final 2024-2025 Submission Reminder!
