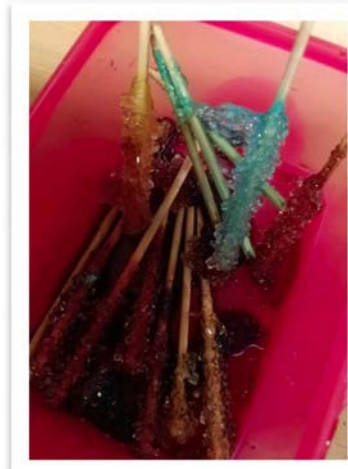
WPS SHOWCASE: SCHOOL LIFE, NEWS AND LEARNING ACHIEVEMENTS

YEAR 2 GREAT FIRE OF LONDON

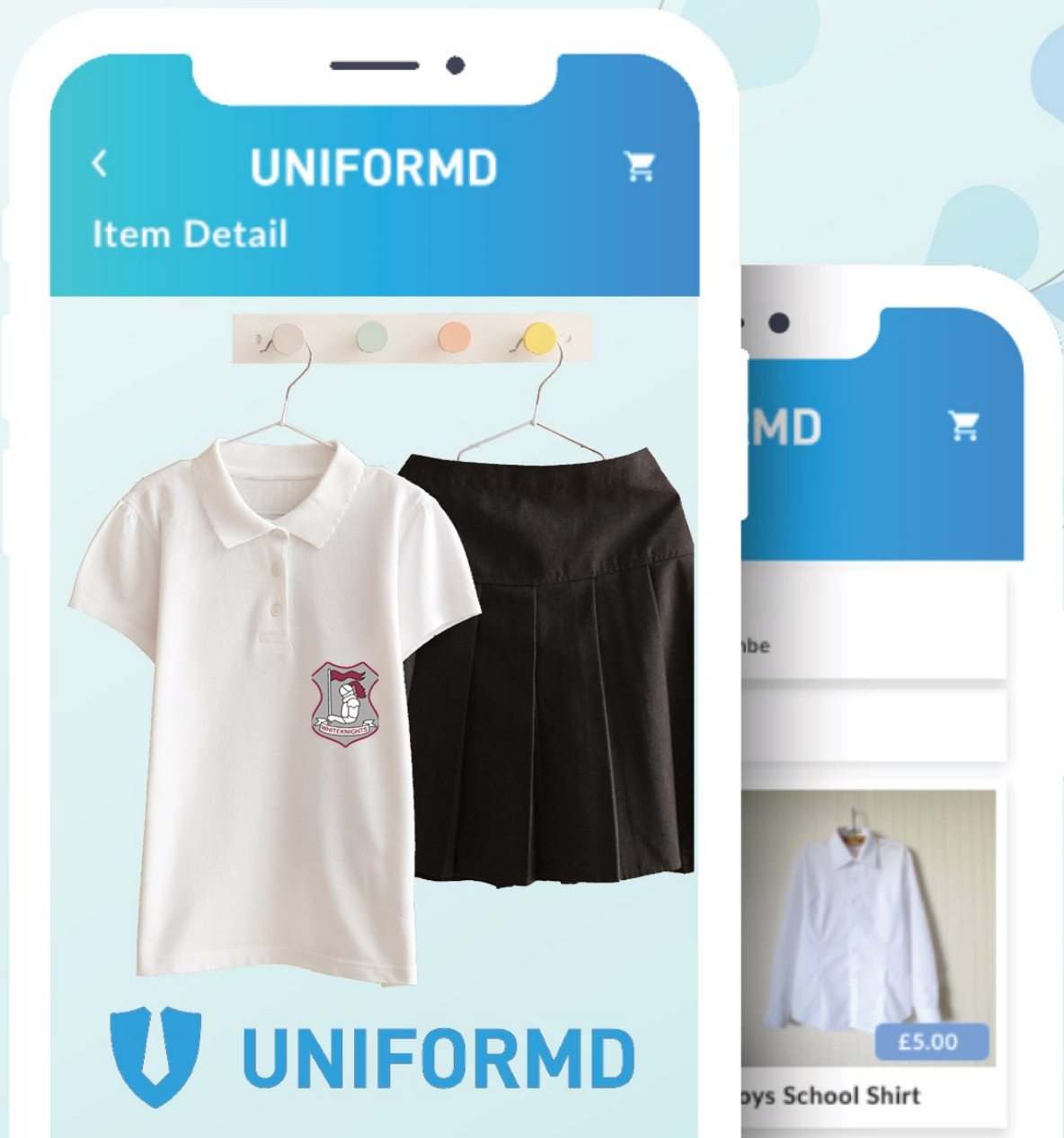
