FLU IMMUNISATIONS RECEPTION TO YEAR 6—TUESDAY 30 SEPTEMBER 2025:

NOTICES & RENINDERS The nursing team will be in school on Tuesday 30th September to administer flu immunisations for pupils in Reception to Year 6. You should already have received information and instructions about giving consent. Please ensure you complete a YES or NO consent form for each child using the links in the instruction document, and include your school's unique code: BK109839.

All forms must be submitted by 9am the day before the session (at least 24 hours in advance) so the team has time to review them.

AMENDMENTS TO END OF DAY ARRANGEMENTS:

If there are changes to end of day arrangements e.g. different adult picking up children, these need to be communicated to the school office by 14:30 at the very latest. We cannot guarantee that messages received after this time will reach the teacher.

KS2 LEAVING THE CLASSROOM UNACCOMPANIED:

With parental consent through ARBOR, our Year 3's will have the option to leave the classroom unaccompanied at the end of the school day. This may mean simply meeting their grown up by the school gate or a siblings classroom, walking just down the road to meet at the car or walking all the way home! You can view a USEFUL **GUIDE** on our website to help you make a decision about whether or not it is safe for your child to leave the classroom/school premises unaccompanied.

END OF TERM TIME CHANGE:

In line with BPET expectations, we have amended the end-of-term finish times. Previously, the school day ended at 1:00pm; this will now be 3:20pm, the same as a normal school day. Please note that, as before, there will be no after-school clubs or extended care on the

last day of term.

ARBOR—CONSENT FOR USE OF IMAGES (PHOTOGRAPHS, VIDEOS, AND **DIGITAL IMAGES) OF YOUR CHILD**

As mentioned last week, as part of BPET we have updated our consent forms for taking images of pupils. We love celebrating the achievements of our children, and this often means capturing them in photographs (occasionally video) to share with our wider community.

Images can be displayed on the school or BPET's websites, social media, in (e)newsletters and printed publications, on the school's learning platforms, in physical displays and press. Images are not routinely published and renewed consent will be sought if a press opportunity arises.

To comply with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) we need your consent to take images of your child and use them in the ways described below:

1. School and BPET

Permission for your child's image or video to be used in the school's/BPET's newsletters, website, learning platforms and school display boards. Occasionally these may include social media (for example: while on a school trip or residential visit).

2. Local press

Permission for your child's image or video to be used in <u>occasional press</u> releases for local press. Renewed consent will be sought if the press opportunity requires naming your child (for example: if your child wins a prize, raises money for a cause).

Consent preferences can now be managed through the Arbor App. Please note that all families—both new and existing—must complete these updated permissions, as any previous image consents are no longer valid.

Thank you to those families who have already submitted their consents via the Arbor App.

NON-PRESCRIBED MEDICATION IN SCHOOL:

For emergencies only situations, the school office may administer non-prescription medication provided that verbal consent (this includes Arbor consents) has been obtained in advance. The medications we hold in school are: **Calpol** Infant 2+ month; Calpol SixPlus 6+ years; Nurofen for Children 3 months—12 years; Piriton 1+ years; Nivea Kids Sensitive 50+ Sun Cream.

If your child is currently in Year 6 of a primary or junior school, you will need to apply for a Year 7 place in a secondary school for **September 2026**.

You can name up to four schools on your application and must apply through your home authority even if your preferred schools are in another local authority area.

Reading residents (who pay Council Tax to Reading Borough Council) should **apply using the link below**. If you live outside Reading (e.g. West Berkshire or Wokingham), you must apply through the school admissions service of your own local authority.

We will reflect back over the last year to review our successes and lessons learnt, and we will share details about our finances and discuss plans for this year.




